


- 1960s and 1970s...economy BOOMING years...

PADOVA SOLARE: THE INITIATIVE

• GOAL: 500-1000 PV Plants in the city

 CONSORTIUM: Comune, PV panels local producers, Banks

• **PLANTS SIZE**: $3 - 6 \text{ kW}_p$ for single house, for condominiums to 20 kW_p










PADOVA SOLARE: THE SCHEME

All material costs, installation costs and insurance cost are included (20 years)

All bank conditions are comprised (100% 20 years loan repayed by GSE feed-in tariffs



700+ requests in 3 months












BETTING ON THE FUTURE: GREEN INDUSTRIAL AREAS


• ...the results...the city is 3rd in the national context for PV plants on private roofs and the PV plants of Communal estates cover the 50% of total electric public needs















WHAT IS IT?


- The PadovaFIT! PDA action proposes to boost this local commitment by delivering a large scale, housing retrofit programme of EE and RES measures sustained by an innovative financing scheme allowing all interested householders to have access to the measures
- To do so, CPD has brought together a team of experienced local private stakeholders (an ESCo, a cooperative bank, a higher education non-profit foundation and an engineering company) willing to risk and invest in the creation of the PadovaFIT! scheme.

















THE ACTION

- The action will make it possible to bundle a critical mass of small and differentiated investment projects making them bankable through dedicated financing schemes.
- PADOVA FIT! enables the City Council to act as a facilitator and institutional guarantor for the bundling of small projects and make them bankable, without necessarily enjoying the financial benefits of the action.
- It will also use a repayment model based on the regular billing of supplies such as electricity or gas












EXPECTED RESULTS


- 15.800.000,00 € of foreseen investments launched in the private housing building sector (with possibility to add a share of public housing and service facility buildings
- ca. 4500 people affected by the investments (over 2% of total population of the project area)
- ca. 4.850 tCO2e/year of avoided GHG emissions
- ca. 15.200 Mwh/year of primary energy savings
- ca. 2.300 Mwh/year of Renewable energy produced
- a brand new PadovaFIT! financing scheme
